The five neighborhood associations comprising *Grandmont Rosedale Communities* will host their 12th Annual Neighborhood Open House on Sunday, May 7, from 1-5 p.m.

Homes for sale will be open in varied styles and price, with sale prices ranging from \$75,000 to \$280,000 and most homes selling within two weeks of being listed.

Grandmont Rosedale residents will be opening their homes that day for viewing, so that visitors can get a first-hand feel of what it's like to live in one of Detroit's most desirable neighborhoods. Bus tours, narrated by local residents, will run throughout the afternoon, highlighting neighborhood amenities and some featured homes.

Grandmont Rosedale has benefitted in recent years from millions of dollars in investments by foundations, the City and the Detroit Land Bank Authority, much of it targeted for housing rehab by the neighborhood-based Grandmont Rosedale Development Corporation (GRDC).

The Detroit HomeLIFT program provides eligible homebuyers with \$15,000 in down payment assistance on qualified properties. Buyers meeting low income requirements are eligible for a 0% interest-free loan from the city after six months to make repairs to their property, while in a designated portion of Grandmont Rosedale, no income limits apply. All buyers are eligible for the City's 15-year tax abatement on any property within the area.

This popular event is hosted by the community associations of North Rosedale Park, Rosedale Park, Grandmont, Grandmont #1 and Minock Park, in conjunction with the GRDC.

Visitors must register at the *North Rosedale Park Community House*, 18445 Scarsdale, three blocks west of the Southfield Freeway and four blocks north of Grand River, where they can obtain a listing of homes that will be open that day and get information on financing options, insurance resources and tax abatement. **Mental Health Awareness Month**

May is Mental Health Awareness Month...There's a tragic story nearly every day in the media about someone suffering from mental illness, hurting themselves or someone else. We've all seen them, and they are becoming more frequent.

Mental Illness is described as a condition that impacts a person's thinking, feeling or mood and may affect his or her ability to relate to others and function on a daily basis. Each person will have different experiences, even people with the same diagnosis. Recovery is possible; including meaningful roles in social life, school and work, especially when you start treatment early and play a strong role in your own recovery process.

But, it is important to know the symptoms of some of the more common behavioral disorders, especially in children. Here are just a few: conduct disorders; aggression to people and animals and destruction of property, deceitfulness or stealing, serious violations of rules. Another common children's disorder—Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD): Fails to give close attention to details or



makes careless mistakes in school work or activities, difficulty sustaining attention in tasks or play; often does not seem to listen or follow-through on instructions; has difficulty organizing tasks and activities; often avoids, dislikes, or is reluctant to engage in tasks that require sustained mental effort (e.g., schoolwork or homework).

Northeast Guidance Center (NEGC), at 20303 Kelly Rd., in Harper Woods, takes an entire 'family approach' to help children with severe behavioral difficulties live up to their full potential. The Children and Family Services

program offer comprehensive services to children from birth through age 17 as well as family support.

According to data from Community Network Services (CNS) and Northeast Guidance Center (NEGC), while one in five Americans lives with mental disorders, estimates indicate that nearly two-thirds of all people with a diagnosable disorder do not seek treatment, especially people from diverse communities. Why? Lack of knowledge and fear of rejection from members of the public, from friends, family and co-workers, and even at times from the very service systems that they turn to for help – all of which can have a more devastating impact on them than the illness itself.

NEGC and CNS will host an *Anti - Stigma Forum* to promote Mental Health Awareness Month and create awareness for Human Trafficking on May 4. Keynote speaker will be Theresa Flores, Human Trafficking Survivor. For info call (313) 308-1416.

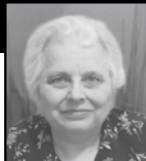

Hundreds of dogs, cats, puppies and kittens will be available for immediate adoption to loving homes at one of the nation's largest off-site companion animal adoption events.

Presented by Purina, *Meet Your Best Friend at the Zoo* will be held outdoors under tents in the Zoo's front parking lot beneath the landmark water tower. There is no charge for admission or parking for the adoption event; regular admission and parking fees apply for those visiting the Zoo.

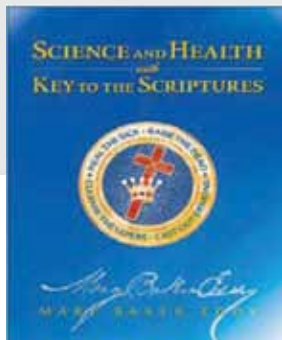

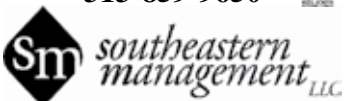

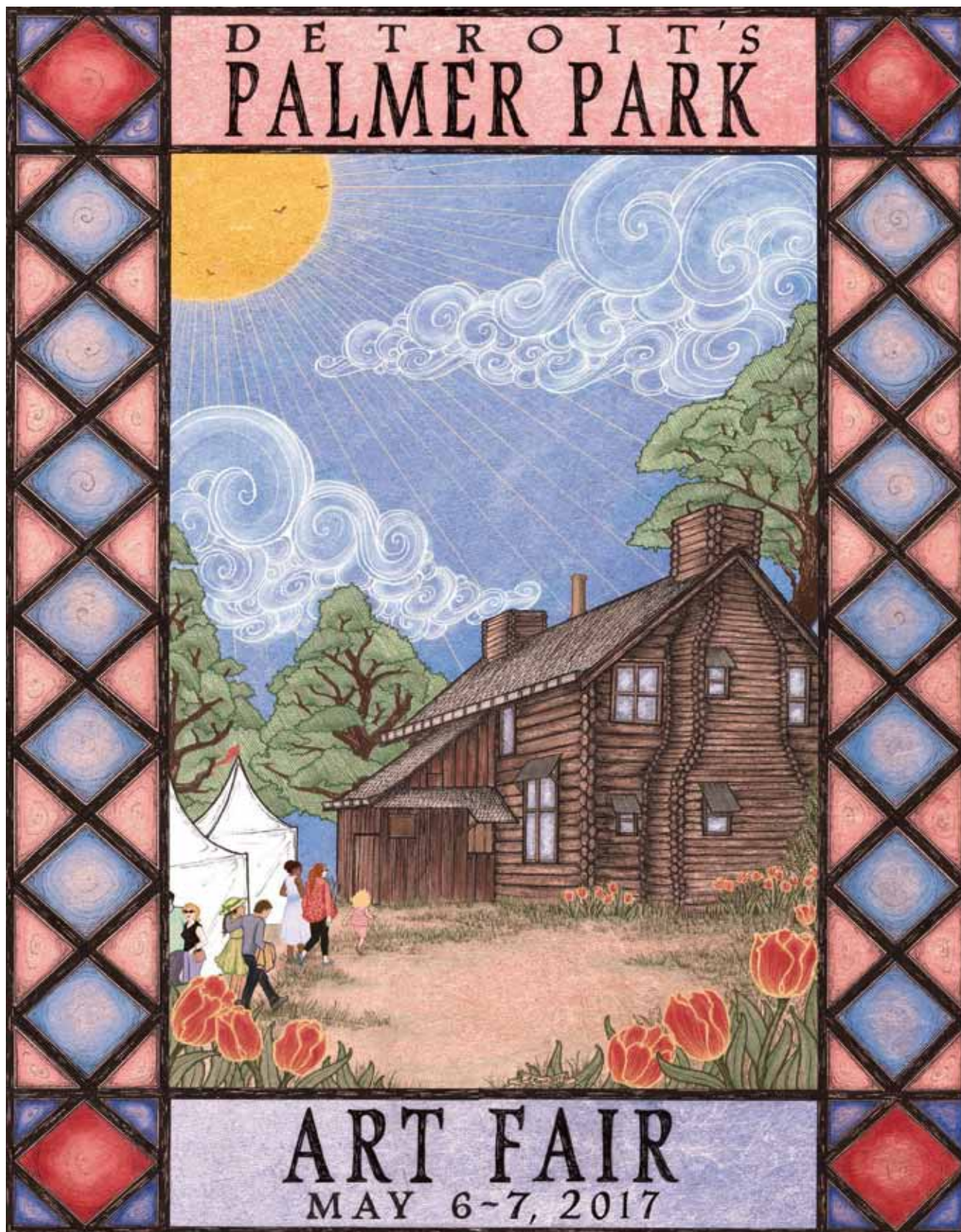
