167th Annual Highland Games



Bagpipe and Drum Bands will Perform

The St. Andrew's Society of Detroit will host its *167th annual Highland Games* on Friday and Saturday, August 5-6 at **Livonia's Greenmead Historical Park.** The Greater Detroit games are the oldest continuously held games in all of North America.

Founded in 1849, the St. Andrew's Society of Detroit is a nonprofit organization dedicated to preserving Scottish heritage through art, customs, dress, literature and traditional games.

The *Highland Games* will begin with a traditional *Celidh* (party) on Friday evening, August 5, from 5-11 p.m. featuring live entertainment, that will also be featured during the games on Saturday from 8:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Two stages of continuous entertainment will feature national and regional Celtic and Scottish artists, including the chance to see authentic **bagpipers and traditional dancers**. Other highlights of the Games, besides the popular *Pipe Bands and Highland Dance and Fiddle* competitions, include *Heavy Athletic* games, featuring the *Caber Toss*, where participants throw a 19.5 foot tall tree trunk, or caber, weighing over 175 pounds, a *Hammer Throw* contest, and other games of strength involving heavy weights, and even a traditional *Haggis Hurl!* (Haggis, is the ancestral Scottish food of savory pudding encased in a sheep's stomach).

Other activities and participatory events include a *Massed Band* presentation taking place Saturday at 12:30 p.m., a *Tug-O-War*, the *Parade of Clans* at 11:40 a.m. on Saturday, featuring clans from across the U.S., a *Wee Bairns* area for young children, and a large and diverse marketplace of Celtic crafts, merchandise and collectibles with Scottish and other food vendors.

Guyton 30th Anniversary Exhibition

Opening August 13 at Inner State Gallery, Detroit's Tyree Guyton will celebrate the 30th anniversary of The Heidelberg Project with his latest solo exhibition Face-ology, a career spanning showcase, featuring new works by the founder and creative force of the city's most iconic public art installation.



"Face-ology is a reflection of everything that is changing about Detroit; the face of the landscape, the face of the people and even my own face. This show also talks about the challenges we face as a nation. I'm revealing what's underneath the face—I'm pulling off the covers," Guyton (pictured) said from his Detroit studio.

Face-ology is a new body of work including works on paper that capture the faces and emotions of the community that continue to shape Guyton's world. Caricature-styled imagery that completely eludes any reference to race or ethnicity, Guyton's faces are consistent through his bold use of colors and his signature wide-toothed grins. However, this work is layered with an intense and hauntingly raw ambiguity that



draws you in and takes you on a journey. Guyton's faces have been his most iconic and most-collected series throughout his career.

"We are celebrating 30 years of making social change through art in many ways," Heidelberg Project Executive Director Jenenne Whitfield said. "Guyton's work is not slick and shiny, it's raw and it's real and that makes it great!!"

Headstrong's music was composed by Wesley Fishwick. Fishwick is known to me in particular because he was one of the more outstanding students of legendary DSO pianist Misha Kottler, and studied with Kottler for some years. Foot Health Today

MILD HAMMERTOE

QUESTION: My eight year old daughter seems to have slightly deformed toes. They curl under at the tip and the middle one is partially obscured by the one next to it. Is this anything to be concerned about?

ANSWER: Few people have perfectly formed toes. However, because something is common doesn't mean it should be ignored. An out-of-line toe can interfere with walking and be the source of a lifetime of chronic corns.

Your podiatrist may prescribe orthoses or fitted inserts to restore normal foot function and remove pressure from the cramped area, or he may advise a wait and see attitude — only an examination will determine the best course.



'American Wee Pie' Serves Up Well Done Food for Thought

I've written aplenty about the inviting and attractive setting of the Tipping Point Theatre, But, as redundant as it may be to voice praise about the Tipping Point's physical appearance and location - an architecturally handsome stand-alone playhouse nestled just downhill from Northville's spotless picture-postcard downtown - among other accolades that I keep at the ready, is this one: I've never seen a poorly done production at the Tipping Point.

For sure, live theatre rarely goes through an entire show without a tongueslip, or a misplaced foot, or some kind of off-the-script imperfection. That's what makes it 'live.'

But, those aren't the only miscues that can happen with live theatre. Other detractions can come from the actors themselves, the technical staging, the direction, and inevitably, the choice of the written material itself. All of these singular elements of a show have to blend together with strengths of their own to be a truly high-level production. And, as I've said, none of these single parts of a show has ever failed the whole of a Tipping Point production.

So it is with their current show, the Michigan premiere of *American Wee Pie*. At first hearing, the name could lead you to believe it's a kid's show – maybe something to do with childhood. And, in a way, that's true. Nothing to do with children, but, everything to do with fully mature adults, disassociating

themselves from the lives they've grown into, and choosing to reinvent themselves. The story is simple: You are never too old to become new again.

Here's the set-up:


Zed (Brian P. Sage), a middle-aged textbook editor has come back to his non-descript little hometown of Gardensend when his mother passes away. He's lived in Chicago for decades, and this is the first time he's returned to his boyhood home.

On the way to his mother's house, he obliviously walks into oncoming traffic. He's pulled from harm's way by Linz (Stacey J. Weddle), a completely forgotten-about high school classmate. Linz is effusively upbeat, energetic and aggressively chatty, and invites the morose Zed to visit the cupcake shop that she owns with her eccentric French baker husband, Pableau (Peter Prouty).

Zed doesn't say yes to the invitation right away. He first goes to his mother's house, where he sees his sister (Kelly Komlen), herself not happy at all with the way that her life has turned out.

Zed and his sister talk for a bit about the state of their miserably mundane lives, and Zed professes that his job has sucked the life out of him and everyone who works there, including his cubby-mate, who appears as a raunchy-mouthed bike riding apparition throughout the play. (This part is played by Wayne David Parker, who appears in a trio of roles, each one important to the story.)

Eventually, Zed visits Linz and the strangely focused

Pableau at their gourmet cupcake emporium. When Zed takes a taste of one of Pableau's peculiarly flavored cupcakes, everyone's life changes...suffice it to say that a first bite could perhaps create a second chance.

Tipping Point's Managing Director James R. Kuhl, talked about the Lisa Dillman play, and put it pretty well: "I think audiences will find a lot of inspiration from *American Wee Pie*. It's very encouraging to any-

one who feels like there may be something more out there for them."

I totally agree.


